This show is open to PAL members only

*COVID restrictions may apply and will be determined prior to show.

- EXHIBIT DATES: Monday, May 23 – Thursday, July 14
- ENTRY DEADLINE: May 1
- ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION: May 12
- DELIVERY of ART DATE: Saturday, May 21, Deliver to the Aspen Surgery Center, 133 La Casa Via, Walnut Creek 10:00 – 10:30 am – *No art will be accepted after 10:30 am. Plan to arrive on time! If assistance with delivery is needed, help will be available, see contact information below.
- PICK UP ART: Friday, July 15. 11:30am – 12:00 pm only.
- ENTRY FEE: \$30 (*non-refundable*) includes up to 3 entries. In support of JMH community initiatives, PAL will donate \$200 on behalf of their artists. The maximum number of pieces in this show will be up to 40 pieces (depending on size of art works).
- THIS IS A JURIED SHOW: Digital images of each entry must be submitted online with entry.

The John Muir Health Auxiliary Gallery at Aspen Center recognizes the ambiance of healing is important to patients, their family and friends, staff, volunteers and healthcare practitioners, so “**wellness**” or “**wellbeing**” should be reflected in the content of the artwork. Animals, landscapes, nature, abstract works and portraits not of political or controversial content are acceptable.

JUROR: Jody Mattison

REQUIREMENTS: PAL members over 18 yrs only. The work must be 2D and wholly original. Entries must not have been shown in any previous JMH show nor previously won a PAL award. No workshop or class work allowed. John Muir Health reserves the right to refuse to exhibit any artwork that it determines, in its sole discretion, to be unsuitable for exhibition in the Auxiliary Gallery. Subject matter that may be objectionable to the public (nudity, obscenity, extreme political or religious views) will be disqualified at the discretion of the show organizers.

Size: Minimum size: 16"x20" including frame / Maximum size: 30"x40" including frame / Maximum weight: 8 pounds. No glass will be accepted.

Framing guidelines: These guidelines are intended to help ensure your artwork and handler's safety. Paintings considered unsafe for hanging may be disqualified at the discretion of the show organizers.

- Oil, acrylic, and mixed media paintings may be presented unframed if the work is on gallery wrapped canvas, meaning canvas adhered to the back of the stretcher bars, not the sides. All edges must be finished with paint and no staples, brads, or other fasteners may be visible from the front or sides.
- Watercolor and Pastels etc. Watercolors, pastels, etc. must be either sealed and varnished or framed with Plexiglass (acrylic) covering required. NO GLASS will be accepted.
- Neat & sturdy wood or metal frames with square corners. No ornate or Rocco frames. NO GLASS
- Picture frame hangers must be D ring flush type hangers, No saw tooth, eye hooks or clamps. The wire must be fastened securely with wire ends taped. The center of the wire should reach no closer than 2" from the top of the frame (not visible above frame when hung).
- The Auxiliary Gallery is not responsible for any damages.

LABELS: A downloadable artist's label will be provided on the PAL web site to be attached by the artist on the back of artwork in the upper left corner.

AWARDS:

Best of Show: \$150, Merit Award: \$100 (2), Honorable Mention: \$50 (4)

ENTER AND PAY ONLINE:

You must enter online and may pay with credit card through PayPal online. You will be asked to upload your digital images when filling out the entry form on PAL's website: (<https://www.pal-art.com/call>).

Members may enter up to 3 images in jpeg format, we recommend sizing at exactly 1200 pixels on the longest side, one painting per file. Show image only, without frame.

Name your artwork file as: *lastname_artworktitle*, (for example: Smith_Sea View.jpg). To enter, Go to Call for Artists page on PAL's web site (<http://www.pal-art.com/call>) , click on enter here, follow entry and online payment directions.

SALES:

All sales of artwork will be handled by PAL, limited to a maximum of sales value of \$1,500. PAL will collect the gross sales price, will retain 20% of the gross price net of taxes and will remit 80% of the gross sales price to the artist. A 10% contribution to JMH will be made from the PAL retention. PAL is responsible for collection and reporting of the sales tax adhering to all State and Federal laws. Checks for sales will be generated and mailed to artist within 30 days of show closure.

CONDITIONS AND LIABILITIES:

Insurance: JMH will maintain property damage and loss insurance on The Auxiliary Gallery Exhibition's artwork while on display at the Aspen Center. The maximum purchase price, per painting, covered by this insurance is \$1,500 with a \$500 deductible. "Not for Sale" artworks will not be insured by JMH. JMH and PAL are NOT responsible for the \$500 deductible.

No work may be withdrawn before the end of the show or entered into a concurrent show. Artists that fail to meet the accepted entry requirements will be disqualified. JMH and PAL reserve the right to photograph artwork or copy images for promotional purposes.
